

Western Springs Service Club—Rules and Regulations

1. Members and their guests are responsible for familiarizing themselves with and complying with all pool rules and regulations.
2. WSSC reserves the right to suspend or terminate any privileges of someone who allows his pass to be used by another person, repeatedly violates pool rules, or disrupts the orderly, safe operation of the pools.
3. All children 9 years and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
4. Personal flotation devices such as swimmies, inner tubes, rings and jackets, are not a substitute for your supervision of your children.
5. No personal flotation devices may be used on the slides.
6. Pool management may limit or prohibit the use of large flotation devices.
7. No water projection devices (squirt guns, etc.) will be allowed on pool property.
8. The wading pool is reserved for children 5 years old and younger. Parents/guardians must accompany their children in this area. No lifeguard is on duty.
9. The west pool is restricted to adults and to children entering 5th grade or older.
10. Lap swimmers in the west pool do not have the right of way outside the lap lanes.
11. Fins and snorkels may be used in the west pool only.
12. Guard instructions must be followed.
13. Personal conversations with lifeguards on duty are prohibited.
14. Lifeguards are not responsible for catching children off the diving board or slides. Swimmers must be able to swim the width of the drop slide area unassisted.
15. To use the diving board, a swimmer must be able to swim the width of the diving well area.
16. Diving is allowed in the west pool only. Only one person may use the board at a time. No double bounces are allowed. Divers are to use the front edge of the board. No diving off sides is allowed. Management and guards may further limit diving as conditions warrant.
17. The following items are not allowed on the pool decks: glass objects of any kind or food and drink. All food must be consumed in the concession area.
18. WSSC is a non-smoking facility. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.
19. All persons must take a soap shower before entering the pool.
20. Remember to use sun block. There is no safe exposure level to the sun.
21. No running, roughhousing or other dangerous behavior is allowed.
22. Management reserves the right to adopt and enforce such other regulations necessary or desirable for the safe and orderly operations of the pools.

East Pool – Monday thru Friday	11:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Baby Pool – Monday thru Friday (beginning Monday, June 13 th)	9:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

(Children 5 years and younger only, and must be accompanied by an adult)

Please note the following daily restrictions:

5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.	West Pool: no children under age 16. East Pool: Family Swim – children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
7:00 p.m. to closing	5 th grade and younger must be accompanied by an adult.
